

## Child Health Other Programs

**CMARC** - Program offered at no charge for children birth to 5 years of age who have long-term medical conditions; and /or are dealing with challenging levels of stress; and/or are referred by the child's doctor.

**CMHRP** - Pregnancy Care Management services are available to pregnant women enrolled in North Carolina Medicaid statewide, and to a limited number of low income, uninsured pregnant women in some counties. Pregnancy Care Managers are registered nurses or social workers who work with clients and their prenatal care providers to ensure the best possible care during pregnancy and after delivery.

**Postpartum/Newborn** - The postpartum/newborn home visiting program is a Medicaid funded home visiting program for residents of Rockingham County. The focus of the visit is an assessment by a registered nurse (RN) of the mother and her newborn, counseling, teaching and referrals as needed.

**WIC** - The WIC program is a supplemental nutrition program for pregnant/breastfeeding/postpartum women, infants and children (age one to five). Participants must be income eligible and have a medical/nutritional risk factor. Vouchers for nutritious foods and nutrition education are provided for each client.

**Lead** - Program to follow and ensure care for children in Rockingham County with elevated lead levels.

**Sickle-Cell** - Program to follow and ensure care for children in Rockingham County with Sickle-Cell disease or Sickle-Cell trait.

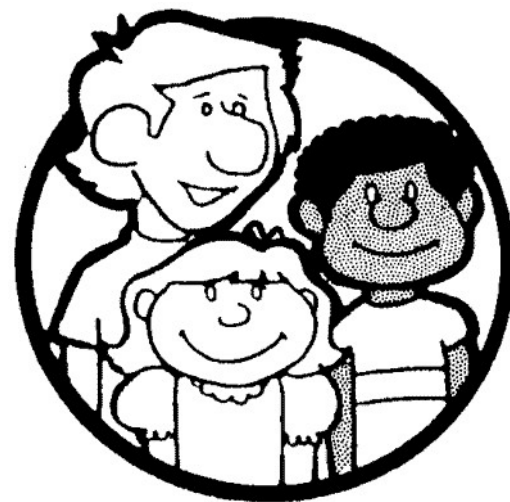

# Child Health Services

The purpose of Child Health services is to maintain good health. Good health is maintained by:

- **Prevention of illness**
- **Early detection and referral**
- **Educational guidance**

## Physical/Well Child Exam

Screenings for growth and development:

- **Annual Well Child Exams**
- **Kindergarten**
- **Day Care**
- **Camp**
- **Headstart**
- **School Exams**



## Lab Services

- **Hemoglobin** (blood test)
- **Urinalysis** (urine test)
- **Lead Screening** ages 1 - 6 years (test the levels of lead in the body)
- **Sickle Cell** (test for Sickle Cell traits)
- **Glucose** (test for Diabetes)

## Services

- **Immunizations** to protect from vaccine preventable diseases.
- **Dental Assessments** using dental varnish to prevent cavities.
- **Asthma Clinic** monitors condition and educates how to manage it.
- **Developmental Screenings** to assess growth & development in motor skills, social, and language behavior.
- **Vision & Hearing Screenings** testing eyes and ears.
- **Nutritional Consultation** to assess diet and maintain proper nutrients in diet.



## Pediatric Primary Care

This program provides diagnostic treatment, prevention, and follow-up services to patients from birth up to 21 years old. Clients must meet financial eligibility. Services include:



- **Sick Visits**
- **Work Physicals**
- **Sport Physicals**
- **Post Trauma Care**
- **Emergency Room Follow - Up Care**
- **Referrals to Specialists**
